

Photo Centerpiece and Personalize Napkin Holders

Before the holiday, invite your guests to send you copies of family photos that you can then spray-mount to card stock. To age contemporary color digital photos, print them in sepia or black and white.



The idea is very easy and adds a special touch to your Thanksgiving Table setting for friends and family.

I use Photo Shop but most photo editing programs allow you to print your photos in black and white or sepia finish. By printing several different sizes of photo it is easier to display the photos.

You could back your photos on decorative paper or place them in inexpensive frames.

My favorite part of this décor is to personalize the napkin holders for each guest. Join me on Page 2 for the simple instructions.

Photo Napkin Holders



I love black and white photos they bring out special qualities of friends and family. By the way this is my Granddaughter who lives in Uruguay, SA

1. Print your favorite photo of each guest.
2. Trim the photo to the shape and size that will cover the front of your napkin.
3. You can also back the photo with craft paper or scrapbooking paper stock.



4. Punch a hole in each side of the photo (Depending on your ribbon you might need to punch a double size hole).
5. Cut the ribbon about 5-6 inches long depending on the size of the napkin and cut both ends of the ribbon at an angle.
6. With ribbon right side up thread both ends through the punch holes on the photo.
7. Slide you cloth napkin between the ribbon and the photo and it's time for the guest to arrive.
